














COUNTRY MIGRATION OVERVIEW



MIGRATION GOVERNANCE

The strategic objective of the migration governance initiative is to achieve full benefit of migration through planned, well managed and well governed migration policies and services



Country Priorities

- Strengthening migration governance
- Regional consultative process and global migration discourse
- · Mainstreaming migration into national and sectoral policies
- Strengthening Immigration and Border Management

- Adopt 'whole of government' and 'whole of society' approach in improving overall migration governance in the country
- Focus on incorporating migrant-centred rights and evidence-based approach in policy formulation and implementation
- Enhance capacity of and processes for effective migration management services







MIGRATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The strategic objective of the migration and development initiative aims to advance socio-economic well-being of the migrants, families and societies by implementing effective migration management services and ensuring humane and orderly migration



Country Priorities

- Skills development and upgradation
- Mainstreaming migration in different development sectors (Health, Education, Environment)
- Remittances and financial literacy

- Enhancing development impact of remittance through evidence based programming on remittance management including financial literacy and debt mediation
- \bullet Ensure skills for migration components are implemented effectively
- Development and implementation of a comprehensive migrant centred sustainable reintegration interventions
- Mainstreaming migration in different socio-economic sectors and different levels of government structures in Bangladesh using a 'whole of government approach'
- Forge effective partnership with Government of Bangladesh and private sector to promote ethical recruitment of migrant workers
- Promotion of safe migration through information and awareness raising for potential migrants















MIGRANT PROTECTION AND ASSISTANCE

The strategic objective of migrant protection and assistance initiative is to ensure human rights for all vulnerable migrants by providing protection services and assistance to the migrants and preventing human trafficking and other exploitative practices



Country Priorities

- Mainstreaming protection
- 4 Ps (Prevention, Protection, Prosecution, Partnership) of counter trafficking
- Eliminating modern slavery and trafficking in Bangladesh
- Special attention to the most vulnerable among the Victims of trafficking (unaccompanied minors, disable), health for victims of trafficking

- Promote victim-centred approach in the protection programming with the focus on four Ps (Prevention, Protection, Prosecution and Partnership)
- Provide technical support to Government of Bangladesh in strengthening the prosecution along the lines of The Human Trafficking and Suppression Act (2012)
- Mainstream Protection in all migration management services
- Sensitize law enforcement agencies and legal experts in Bangladesh on protection issues of victims of trafficking
- Forge partnership with the private sector to address issues of modern slavery and trafficking











EMERGENCIES AND STABILIZATION

The strategic objective of the emergencies and stabilization initiative attempts to prevent and prepare for crisis, support migrants, displaced persons and communities affected by crises in accordance with humanitarian principles and promote durable solutions to end displacement



Country Priorities

- Immediate response to the crisis affected communities with life saving interventions
- Humanitarian Development Nexus
- Disaster Risk Reduction (preparedness, resilience)
- Environment and Climate Change
- Livelihood

- Bring humanitarian development linkages into the programming under emergencies and stabilization
- Mainstream Migration, Environment and Climate Chance (MECC) in Bangladesh
- Promote MCOF framework to support the Government in managing displaced population in the wake of disasters and emergencies in Bangladesh
