

According to available data from the Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) Europe<sup>1</sup> compiled in the following snapshot by the DTM REMAP project funded by the European Union, 804 irregular Bangladeshi nationals arrived by sea and by land in Europe by entering Greece, Italy or Spain in 2018. The highest share of Bangladeshi nationals was registered in Spain (56% of the total arrivals by land and by sea). Additionally, 1,320 Bangladeshi nationals were identified while transiting through the Western Balkan (WB) countries during the same year.
