General Functions:

Under the overall supervision of the Primary Health Care (PHC) Coordinator and the direct supervision of the Medical Officer, the successful candidate will be responsible for the carrying out the following duties and responsibilities in relation to the UN clinic in Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities:

- 1. Drive and operate an ambulance and transport emergency patients as a roster duty 24/7.
- 2. Ensure the ambulance is fully fit to travel and check the vehicle conditions as prescribed tools are cross-checked daily.
- 3. Ensure the servicing of the ambulance is properly done periodically as standards of maintenance protocol.
- 4. Preserve the vehicle documents safely and update it accordingly.
- 5. Carry out regular maintaining of logbook, cleanliness, and taking measures for ensuring infection preventions & controls inside the ambulance.
- 6. Transport office staffs as of emergency needs.
- 7. Ready to work in emergency situations to fix the sanitation problem.
- 8. Submit milage monthly report.
- 9. Perform such other duties that may be assigned by the Supervisor.

Education, Experience, Skills and Language:

- Secondary School Certificate from an accredited academic institution.
- Clean Driver's License issued by the Government of Bangladesh
- At least three years of experience in vehicle driving in a hospital/ clinic.
- Experience in driving in UN organizations/ program will be given preference.
- Knowledge and experience with working in field Hospitals, public health sector, medical emergencies will be advantageous.
- Ability to work effectively under pressure in hardship situations and harmoniously within a team of colleagues from varied cultures and professional backgrounds.
